Program Name: **Substance Abuse Prevention/Education Program**

The Juvenile Services Substance Abuse Program is providing prevention, early intervention and substance abuse educational services to youth and their families referred by the 9th District Judicial Court and the Court Service Units. As a way of identifying youth in the early stages of substance misuse, the program provides substance abuse assessment and evaluation services. The program also provides multi family substance abuse education groups, which focus on reducing risk factors through building family resiliency. Drug screen monitoring is offered to all program participants. Individual and family counseling services are offered to all families in the program who require follow up treatment beyond group services. The programs ultimate goal is to help establish a drug free community.

The York County Juvenile Services Substance Abuse Program provides weekly groups for youth and their families. Groups are implemented in Williamsburg, York County, Gloucester and Mathews County. The group is 90 minutes in length and requires attendance at 6 sessions. The cost of the program is \$100.00 and is not usually covered by insurance. Groups are offered on an on-going basis.
