The Historic Triangle Substance Abuse Coalition in conjunction with the School of Education at the college of William and Mary has organized a tip line designed to stop underage drinking parties before they happen. The goal is to prevent tragic situations from occurring. By anonymously reporting a party where underage drinking is going to be taking place, you may be saving the life of a friend, a loved one, a parent or even yourself.

A dedicated anonymous phone line will connect to the HTSAC office. You can leave tips, about alleged underage drinking parties on an automated voice mail system. The information is forwarded to the appropriate law enforcement agency and in our case, the Chief of Security at Ford's Colony. We will follow up on the tip, by phone or a visit to the residence. The intended outcome is to inform the homeowner about the alleged party and communicate the legal consequences of hosting under age drinking parties.
